ORDER

The petitioner is same in both the HRMPs. In HRMP 518/09 he has stated that the respondents attacked his wife, damaged the house hold articles, threatened her and fenced his property and a complaint was also given before the police against him. As the petitioner did not give any details as to whether he had given any complaint to the police with regard to the illegal acts of the respondents he was asked to furnish the details as to the police authority before whom he had given a complaint.

Thereafter the petitioner filed HRMP.668/09 where in he has stated that he did not give any complaint to any police authority and the respondents have given complaint against him. The averments in the said HRMP therefore show that the petitioner did not give any complaint to the police with regard to the alleged

incident. He has only stated in HRMP No.668/09 that he had given a complaint to the R.D.O. in regard to the property dispute and the averment therefore show that he prefers any complaint to any police authority. The complaint to the R.D.O. relates to civil dispute and therefore it is for the petitioner to get his remedy before the civil court. If he has a complaint that he was assaulted by any of the respondents he has also the liberty to give a complaint at the concerned police station which will enquire the matter according to law.

The petitions are closed.
