**ORDER**

The grievance of the petitioner is that while he was working under Jose Kottooran he suffered injury while unloading articles and no financial assistance was given to him for treatment. According to him, Jose and his accomplices damaged the fence in his property and removed coconuts and other yielding and complaint to Nenmara Police became futile and that Jose also cut and removed the trees belonging to him worth Rs.35,000/- but no action was taken by police.

In the report submitted by the Superintendent of Police, Palakkad, it is stated that the petitioner was working with Jose Kottooran and during the year 1997 he was sent away from service after he was paid Rs.20,000/- and that the petitioner has filed 66 complaints against Jose before several authorities and civil cases are also pending. According to the report, the petitioner fled a case before the High Court of Kerala against Jose and as regards the grievance of the petitioner that he was not given any compensation it is stated in the report that as the matter is pending before the Court final decision will be taken as per the final

order passed by the Court. It is further stated in the report that Crime No 243/99 u/s 9 (b) of the Explosives Act, 1884 was registered against the petitioner by the police and final report was filed before the Court.

In view of the report no further orders can be passed by this Commission as the matter has become subjudiced and also cases are pending before the Courts between the parties.

The petition is therefore closed.
