ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that his daughter, Athulya, a student in Standard IX, Government V.H.S.C., Paruthippally, was harassed by a teacher of the school alleging that she had stolen Rs.100/- from another student and inspite of his complaint to the Principal no action was taken.

A report was called for from the Director of Public Instruction, Thiruvananthapuram. In the report it is stated that he obtained a report from the District Educational Officer, Neyyattinkara, in the matter. In the report it is stated that on receipt of a complaint from the petitioner by the Principal of the school on 30.11.09 he enquired regarding the incident with the Class leader and other students. It is further staged in the report that Sreekala, the teacher, behaved badly to the petitioner's daughter Athulya and asked her to leave the school after obtaining Transfer Certificate. The Principal warned the teacher and also advised the student. Later on 8.1.2010 the said teacher, who was working on daily wage basis, was relieved from the school and thereafter allowed to continue on daily

wage basis till the end of February on the assurance given by the Teachers Organisation.

In view of the above report no further orders are required. The petition is therefore closed.
