ORDER

The complaint of the petitioners is that Muraleedharan Nair, Radhakrishnan

and Jaya are running an institution in the name and style of "Sree Karunalaya"

with registration No.3123/05 in their area and the institution is said to be for

mentally retarded children and in the said institution the boys and girls are not

separately accommodated and there are no facilities which are required in an

institution meant for such children. In the petition it is further stated that the girl

inmates are sexually exploited by the management and many outsiders are also

visiting. According to the petitioners on the complaint received earlier the Sub

Inspector of Police, Maranalloor Police Station inspected the institution and later

directed the authorities to send back the children to the parents but still 3 inmates

are residing in the institution..

In the report sent by the Director of Social Welfare it is stated that the

averments are more or less true. It is stated in the report that the District Social

Welfare Officer (DSO) visited the institution, questioned the authorities and asked

for the records for perusal and they gave vague answers by saying that the

accounts books are with the auditors for auditing and records are given to the

Office of the Superintendent of Police (Rural), Thiruvananthapuram and

Maranalloor Police Station and on verification at Maranalloor Police Station it

came to the knowledge that no such records were given to the Police Station.

According to the report the authorities of the institution did not even give the

registration certificates or registration number of the institution and only stated

that they do not possess such certificates and that it came to the knowledge that the

institution has no approval from the Central Government or National Trust for

accommodating mentally retarded children and that the neighbours complained

about the visitor's visiting the institution in intoxicated stage and cries being heard

from inside the institution.

In view of the above report the Director of Social Welfare will initiate

appropriate steps to conduct a thorough enquiry after giving opportunity to the

authorities of the said institution and the petitioners and then initiate appropriate

action against those who are found guilty.

With the above direction the petition is closed.
