ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that an Angnavadi is functioning in a bad condition on account of the poor condition of the building.

In the report submitted by the District Collector, Kollam, it is stated that the Anganvadi was functioning in the property given to the Government in the year

1986 by one Mr. P. Varghese and later dispute arose after his death since his

children refused to part with the property. According to the report proposal was

sent to the Government for constructing a new building and the proposal is also

included by the Corporation of Kollam in the Project Proposal for the financial

year 2009 – 10.

The petitioner Lillykutty and Mr. Sunil Kumar, Assistant Engineer, Kollam

Corporation, representing the Corporation are present. It is stated by Mr. Sunil

Kumar that at present the Anganavadi is functioning in a rented building for which

the rent is being paid by Kollam Corporation. The petitioner Lillykutty also

admits the same.

In view of the above no further orders can be passed by this Commission as

this Commission has no jurisdiction to go into the question whether the property

which was alleged to have given by Mr. Varghese belongs to the Government or

his legal heir as the dispute is civil in nature.

The petition is therefore closed.
