ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that the respondent neighbors wanted to purchase her property but she refused to sell and hence the respondents are filing

false complaint s before the Police. According to her, on 20-1-2009 they abused

the petitioner and her son and her petition to Nemom Police did not evoke any

response.

In the report submitted by the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Fort,

Thiruvananthapuram, it is stated that the petitioner and the respondents are

neighbours and Ramachandran (R2) requested the petitioner to sell a land to

construct a road but she refused to sell. Thereafter Ramachandran purchased some

land from other neightbours and put up a road for his use. According to the report,

regarding the use of the way and road the parties used to quarrel with each other

and that the complaints filed by the petitioner before the Police Station were

properly enquired. It is further stated that the petitioner filed a petition on 20-2-

2009 and accordingly the parties were summoned and they were strictly warned

not to create any problem and that thereafter they are living peacefully.

The averments in the complaint and the report show that the dispute

between the petitioner and the respondents is civil in nature over which this

Commission has no jurisdiction to interfere in view of clause 17 (f) of the Kerala

State Human Rights Commission (Procedure) Regulations, 2001. The petitioner

has to seek her grievance redressed before a civil Court.

The petition is closed.
