ORDER

The victim Arun's father B. Premkumar is present. Mr. Abraham Mathew, Advocate, who is present and filed his vakkalath today in favour of the petitioner Ajayakumar.

The sum and substance of the allegation in the petition is the death of Arun .P.L. on account of the harassment meted out to him by the school authorities including the Principal, SNVHS, Anad, as well as the President, Parent Teachers Association and the School's local manager.

A report was called for from the District Collector,

Thiruvananthapuram, and Superintendent of Police (Rural)

Thiruvananthapuram. In the report of the Dist. Collector,

Thiruvananthapuram it is stated that the matter was enquired by the

Superintendent of Police, Thiruvananthapuram, and a report was filed

before the Commission. In the said report it is stated that on the

complaint of victim Arun's father (Premkumar) a Crime was registered at

Nedumangad Police Station in Crime No.974/06 u/s.174 Cr.P.C. and

investigation is pending.

In view of the above statement contained in the report I find that

no reason to pass any orders except to say that the investigating agency

which is investigating crime No.974/06 should expedite the investigation

and file their final report before the court in an expeditious manner

especially when the crime was registered in 2006 and no explanation was

given in the report for the delay in conducting the investigation in the

above crime. The Superintendent of Police (Rural) Thiruvananthapuram

will personally instruct the investigating officer to expedite the

investigation in the above crime and file the final report at an early date.

With the above directions the petition is closed.
