ORDER

The complaint of the petitioners in the above HRMP is that though they are working as Social Health Workers in the PHC, Cherinniyoor, they are not given priority for posting them as recognized Social Health Workers.

A Member of this Commission took it on file and called for a report from the District Medical Officer, Thiruvananthapuram.

the Medical Officer, In the report submitted by District Thiruvananthapuram, it is stated that a Committee consisting (1) Medical Officer, Primary Health Centre (2) Panchayat President (3) Concerned Panchayat Ward Members and (4) Junior Health Inspector were selecting the Social Health Workers after conducting interview and the ratio of selection is 1: 1000 i.e. one Health Worker for a population of 1000 individuals. It is also stated in the report that the petitioners were not selected as 3rd petitioner Sheela was in 3rd position and 1st petitioner Sreekumari was in 4th position in the rank list prepared by the above said committee and that there is no mal-practice in the selection.

In view of the report I find that no orders are necessary as the matter relates to service dispute.
