ORDER

The complaint of the petitioners is that the respondents, who are anti social elements and also involved in several cases charged by the Police, are harassing the petitioners. According to them Balakrishnan and Chandrasekharan alias Chandran (R2 and 5) encroached into the house of Erappanal Soman, abused and threatened him. The petitioners are not able to lead a peaceful life and the Police did not take any action against the respondents.

The Deputy Superintendent of Police, Muvattupuzha, forwarded the enquiry report of the Circle Inspector of Police, Muvattupuzha, to this Commission. In the report it is stated that Balakrishnan Nair and Chandrasekharan Nair, sons of Narayanan Nair, are accused in several cases and the respondents are not in cordial with the petitioners. In the report it is stated that

timely actions were initiated against the respondents and that on this complaint the

parties were summoned to the Police Station and the respondents were strictly

warned not to cause any trouble to the petitioners. In the report it is also stated

that in respect of the abuse and threat to Sujatha Soman at 5.15 p.m. on 2-2-2010

by Chandrasekharan Nair crime 230/10 u/s 294 (b), 506 (1) and 509 IPC was

registered against him and the investigation in the said crime is progressing.

In view of the above report no further orders are required since the

investigation in the crime is pending. The investigation officer in the above crime

is to complete the investigation expeditiously and file the final report before the

Court and thereafter intimate the said fact to the petitioners so that they can work

out their remedies before the Court in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court

in Sakri Vasu Vs. State of U.P and Others (AIR 2008 Supreme Court 907).

The petition is accordingly closed.
