ORDER

Petitioner is a Pre-Primary Teacher working in the Government Upper Primary (UP) School, Chakai, and her complaint is that the Council of Thiruvananthapuram Corporation decided to shift Anganwadi No.42 functioning at Thazhasseri to the Government U.P. School, Chakai, and if the said decision is implemented she will loose her job.

This petition was taken on file by a Member of this Commission and a report was called for from the Secretary, Thiruvananthapuram Corporation.

In the report the Secretary, Thiruvananthapuram Corporation has stated that as the said Anganwadi was functioning at Thazhasseri in a rental room which has no basic facilities, an enquiry was made for a suitable place for shifting it and on coming to know that a room is lying vacant at the Govt. U.P. School, Chakai, a decision was taken in the meeting of the Council held on 7-11-2008 to shift the Anganwadi to the Govt. U.P. School, Chakai and that accordingly the Anganwadi was shifted to the said school where it commenced functioning from 20-1-2009.

According to the report, the Government have issued an order in G.O (ORD) No.3737/07/Gen.Edn dated 10-8-2007 authorizing the Local Bodies allowing them to shift the Anganwadies to schools without affecting the ordinary function of the schools and that the Council of the Corporation took the above decision on the basis of the said Order.

In view of the above report no further orders can be passed by this Commission as this Commission has no jurisdiction over policy decisions of the Government and also in view of the fact that the said Anganwadi is functioning in the Government U.P. School, Chakai.

The petition is accordingly closed.
