ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that the remand prisoners Shahul Hameed (Crime No.41`0), Shafeek and Riyas (Crime No.428) were manhandled by the Officials of Central Prison.

The Chief Investigation Officer (CIO) of this Commission was asked to enquire and file the report and the CIO filed his report stating that the case details and address of the victims, name of Police Station, year of occurrence, etc, are not mentioned in the petition. The CIO contacted the Superintendent, Central Prison, Thiruvananthapuram and ascertained that Shafeek, S/o Muhammed Abdulkhader and Riyas, S/o Muhammed Moideen were remanded by the Judicial First Class Magistrate Court – II, Thiruvananthapuram, in connection with crime No.428/08 of Poonthura Police Station.

According to the report, the effort of the enquiry officer to trace out the petitioner became futile and though he contacted over the mobile phone number mentioned in the

petition he came to know that the said number does not belong to the petitioner. Though

notices were issued to Riyas and Shafeek to appear before the enquiry officer on 25-1-

2010 and 24-5-2010 they did not turn up for enquiry.

In view of the above report no further orders are required on this petition since the

petitioner could not be traced out and the so-called victims did not appear before the

enquiry officer in spite of several opportunities.

The petition is hence closed.
