## ORDER

An intimation was received from the Superintendent, Sub Jail, Attingal, intimating the death of Sasilal, U T No.4599 of the prison and that he was asked to submit a detailed report annexing the postmortem certificate and inquest report. In the meantime the National Human Rights Commission, New Delhi has also forwarded the petition received by it to this Commission and the same is numbered as HRMP No.865/08 and the same is clubbed with HRMP No.183/08.

In the report sent by the Superintendent, Sub Jail, Attingal, it is stated that Sasilal, the Under Trial Prisoner (U.T. No.4599) suddenly felt ill and was sent to Taluk Head Quarters Hospital, Chirayinkizh where he was examined by the medical officers and there he died at 5.20 a.m.. The Superintendent, in his report, further stated that the death of Sasilal was informed to his wife by express telegram and that on 8-1-2008 Revenue

Divisional Officer, Thiruvananthapuram conducted inquest, which was vedeographed and

after the inquest the body was handed over to the relatives of the deceased who were also

paid a sum of rupees 750/- for cremation expenses after the body was subjected to

postmortem.

I have perused the postmortem certificate annexed to the report in which the

doctor has opined that the death is on account of 'occlusive coronary artery disease'.

In view of the report of the Superintendent, Sub Jail Attingal, and the postmortem

certificate no further orders are required on this petition. The petition is closed.
