ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that students who are studying Arabic, Sanskrit, etc; are put in separate classes which will adversely affect their feelings and he being a retired teacher there is no rule to conduct religious classes in separate division.

In the report submitted by the Director of Public Instruction, Thiruvananthapuram, it is stated that no direction was issued to separate the students on the basis of language and that the students studying different languages are allowed to sit by mingling with each other. According to the report, the students are accommodated in separate classes only when the above subjects are taught, as they have to study the above languages of their choice. It is also reported that they are not put in separate classes on the basis of their language they study.

In view of the above report no further orders are required. The petition is closed.
