**ORDER**

The complaint of the petitioner is that his wife Saraswathy, his son Vimalkumar, his daughter Sheeba, daughter-in-law Priya and their henchmen were manhandled him when he warned them not to involve in immoral activities.

A Member of this Commission took the petition on file and the Chief Investigation Officer (CIO) of this Commission was directed to enquire and file a report.

After the Member demitted the office the HRMP is placed before me with the report now received. In the report of the CIO it is stated that he sent notices to the petitioner and the respondents for appearing before him for recording their statements. They have accepted the notice but not attended before him for the investigation. The CIO further states that the petition is vague and they did not co-operate with the enquiry.

In view of the above report and also in view of the fact that the petitioner and respondents are not co-operate with the enquiry the petition is closed.
