## ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that though he filed several petitions to Attngal Police alleging that the respondents encroached his property to create pathway after damaging the yieldings, the police did not take any action.

In the report submitted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Attingal, it is stated that the Circle Inspector of Police, Attingal, summoned the parties and they were directed to approach the Revenue authorities to redress their grievance and that the respondents were strictly warned not to cause any nuisance to the petitioner. According to the report, the parties agreed before the C I that they are willing to measure the property through Revenue Officials.
