## ORDER

First petitioner is present representing her as well as other petitioners. The complaint in the petition is that the pathway leading to their houses is narrow and that the respondent constructed a compound wall illegally.

In the report submitted by the Secretary, Varkala Municipality it is stated that the respondent has not put up any illegal construction on the pathway from the main road to the residence of the petitioners and the width of the pathway is 80 cm and to make it one meter as required by the petitioners the respondent has to give 20 cm of his property to which he is not willing and that the petitioners have no right in the matter.

On going through the averments in the petition and the report I am of the view that the petition has to be closed, as it is civil in nature.

The petition is accordingly closed.
