<u>ORDER</u>

The complaint of the petitioners is that their daughter Sruthi Rajendran, a Plus

Two student, attempted to commit suicide by burning on 10-12-2009 and she died at

the hospital on 15-12-2009 and her statement was recorded by the Magistrate at the

hospital to whom she complained about Santhoshkumar who sexually abused her.

According to the petitioners, no proper action was taken by Neyyardam Police in the

matter.

The Superintendent of Police, Rural, Thiruvananthapuram, forwarded the

report of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Nedumangad, to this Commission and

in the said report it is stated that in respect of the incident crime 293/09 u/s 309 IPC

was registered on the statement of the petitioners' son Vishnu Rajendran and the

death note of their daughter was recorded by the Chief Judicial Magistrate at the

Medical College Hospital. In the report it is further stated that the further

investigation in the crime revealed that Santhoshkumar, a relative of the petitioners,

fell in love with Sruthi Rajendran, who after promising her with marriage sexually

abused her several days and hence section 376 IPC was added in the crime and

Santhoshkmar was arrested, produced before the Court which remanded him to

judicial custody. According to the report the accused obtained bail on 6-4-2010 and

the investigation is continuing.

The above report shows that the Police registered crime in respect of the

incident, the accused was arrested, produced before the Court and he later obtained

bail. In the above circumstances, no further orders are required on this petition except

to state that the investigation officer in the crime is to complete the investigation and

file the final report before the Court and thereafter intimate the said fact to the

petitioners. If the petitioners have any grievance thereafter they have to approach the

Court concerned in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in 'Sakri Vasu Vs

State of U.P and Other (AIR 2008 SC 907)'.

The petition is accordingly closed.
