ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that when she was working as the Headmistress in the Al-Sayed LP School R1 Nasar attempted to molest her and harassed her mentally and physically.

A Member of this Commission asked the Chief Investigation Officer (CIO) of this Commission to file a report and accordingly the CIO has filed the report.

In the report the CIO, after examining the petitioner and R1 as W1 and W3 respectively, has stated that the petitioner has committed forgery in the school records and also misappropriated the salary of W2 for which a complaint was given to the Parent Teachers Association of the school on account of which W1 was suspended. It is also stated in the report that the Assistant Educational Officer reviewed the action and extended the suspension of W1 and later W1 approached Karunagappally Police and a crime was registered against W3 which was referred under section 156 (3) CrPC and a case was also registered against the petitioner. In the report it is further stated that the

petitioner also filed a petition against R1 before Kerala Vanitha Commission and approached the High Court of Kerala and as per the order of the Court she is reinstated and now she is working as the Headmistress in the same school. In the report the CIO has finally stated that the allegation against R1 by the petitioner is under the consideration of the Court.

In view of the report no further action is required since the matter has become subjudiced. The petition is hence closed.
