**ORDER**

The complaint of the petitioner is that a person who agreed to marry her as directed by the District Collector later married another lady and he is trying to take financial assistance allowable to her. According to her, when she was at Neyyattinkara Police Station some drivers committed theft of Television, VCR and cash from her house.

In the report submitted by the Superintendent of Police (Rural), Thiruvananthapuram, it is stated that the petitioner was summoned to the Police Station for enquiry in the above HRMP and she demanded Rs.60 lakh from the Police and also wanted to find out a person to marry her and then she went out of the Police Station after quarrelling. According to the report, enquiry was also conducted with regard to the alleged theft but no driver with the name mentioned by the petitioner and a vehicle bearing Number 3282 were seen and that the petitioner did not co-operate with the enquiry and on the contrary quarreled with the Police Officials.

On going through the report I find that no further orders are required from this Commission as it is not within the jurisdiction of the Police to search for a man for the petitioner to marry her and the petitioner also did not give proper details to the Police as regards the theft of articles in her house. The petition is hence closed.
