The complaint of the petitioners is that the respondents obstructed their pathway by digging earth to a depth of 70 feet posing threat to their lives.

In the report submitted by the Secretary, Kulathoor Grama Panchayat it is

stated that the pathway in question is a pathway in existence for a long period and

being used by the public and that the respondents in fact did obstruct the usage of

the pathway by others by digging earth to depth of 70 feet and the Panchayat had

taken steps to prevent the respondents from causing obstruction to the public and

by directing the owner of the land not to construct wall.

In view of the report it is for the Kulathoor Grama Panchayat to take steps

to see that the pathway in question which is being used by the public is not

obstructed by the respondents and if necessary, to conduct an enquiry in the matter

by giving opportunity to all the parties concerned and then decide the issue

according to law.

With the above direction the petition is closed.
