## ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner in the above HRMP is that the respondents gave a complaint to the Kerala State Pollution Control Board without any substance for directing the petitioner to stop his carpenter work.

In the report filed by the Revenue Divisional Officer, Thiruvananthpauram, it is stated that the distance between the petitioner's house and respondents house is 25 feet and that the respondents had given several complaints against the petitioner and on the basis of one of the complaint of the respondent the Kerala State Pollution Control Board issued an order directing the petitioner to stop the carpentry work at his house and later by the order No PCB/TVM – DO/COMP/6489/07 dated 31-5-2008 allowed the petitioner to continue the carpentry work.

In view of the above, it is clear that the petitioner has no longer any grievance as the Kerala State Pollution Control Board has permitted him to continue his carpentry work and hence no further orders are required on this petition.

Accordingly the petition is closed.
