ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that her husband, who is involved in five criminal cases, was arrested by the Police from Aryanad and she has no

information as to the Police officials who arrested him.

The Chief Investigation Officer (CIO) of this Commission was asked to

enquire and file the report and accordingly he has filed his report after recording

the statement of the petitioner and perusing Exhibits A to E which are annexed to

the report.

The report indicates that according to the petitioner she came to know that

her husband was arrested on 2-2-2010 from the house of Asha and was produced

before the Court on 7-2-2010 and later he was released on bail on 13-2-2010.

According to her, her husband is living with Asha, who is separated from her

husband and also have two children, for the past three years. According to her,

she has also any complaint in the matter since she wanted to know the Police

officials who arrested her husband.

According to the CIO, the petitioner's husband was arrested on the warrant

issued by the Court in CC 210/2000 at 12.30 p.m. on 7-2-2010 from Uriyakode by

the Sub Inspector of Police, Aryanad and after he was interrogated his

involvement in another two crimes, namely, crime No.689/09 and crime

No.962/08 registered at Aryanad Police Station and Nedumangad Police Station

respectively also came to the knowledge and that immediately after the arrest the

petitioner was informed and the accused was also produced before the Judicial

First Class Magistrate Court-I, Nedumangad. According to the report, the

petitioner has no further complaint in the matter.

In view of the above statement of the petitioner no further orders are

required on this petition and the question whether the petitioner's husband was

arrested on 2-2-2010 as claimed in the petition or on 7-2-2010 as claimed by the

Police is being a question of fact which will come up for adjudication before a trial

Court this Commission has no jurisdiction to give a finding in the said matter.

Hence the petition is closed.
