ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that he retired from the service of the Kerala State Financial Enterprises (KSFE) Ltd, and he is receiving only EPF pension of Rs.685/-per month and no other pension from the KSFE. His request is either to an order sanctioning a pension from the KSFE or provide a job to his son.

In the report submitted by the Managing Director, KSFE Ltd, Thrissur, it is stated that the petitioner retired from service on 31-1-2002 and enjoyed all the benefits from the KSFE. According to the report, the petitioner is now getting a monthly EPF pension of Rs.685/- and that no other payments due to him are pending. In the report it is further stat that in the Rules of the KSFE there is no provision for additional benefits and that this fact was already informed to the petitioner.

In view of the report no further orders are required on this petition. As regards the request of granting a job to his son it is to be stated that this Commission has no jurisdiction to appoint anybody in any institution. The petition is hence closed.
