ORDER

The above HRMP was registered on an allegation that petitioner's daughter

Remya who was married to Vinod disappeared from her sister Rejitha's house on

23-11-2007 and that in spite of the complaint given to Viyyoor Police Station no action

was taken and further that her son-in-law Vinod was treating her daughter Remya in a

cruel manner and that the petitioner was asked to pay expenses incurred towards the

marriage and divorce proceedings.

In the report sent by the Superintendent of Police, Thrissur it is stated that

petitioner's daughter Remya was married to Vinod on 10-11-2007 and that she went to

her sister's house on 21-11-2007. According to the report, Remya left the house

on 23-11-2007 after informing that she is going to temple and that the Vioyyoor police

registered a crime in crime No.617/07 on the statement of Rejitha, elder sister of Remya.

According o the report, while the investigation was proceeding in the above crime

Remya's mobile phone was seized from the house at Kolazhi and from the call details

found in the mobile phone, the phone number of a person by name Shaji who was a

co-worker of Remya was found and thereafter the said Shaji, Remya's husband Vinod,

the petitioner and Remya's sisters were questioned whose statements are also recorded.

According to the report, Shaji informed the investigating officer that he and

Remya are very close and he took Remya to Ernakulam and that Remya is staying in a

house there as paying guest. According to the report of the SP, thereafter Remya was

traced at Ernakulam on 24-1-2008 and she was produced before the Court and before the

Court Remya stated that she on her own accord went along with Shaji and thereafter the

Court released Remya who then went away with her family members.

In view of the report it is seen that a crime was registered by police for woman

missing and later the police traced her from Ernakulam and produced before the Court

and that Remya informed the Court that she went along with Shaji on her own accord and

later went away with her family members on the order of the Court.

In view of the above report no further orders are required on this petition. Hence

the petition is closed.
