**ORDER**

The complaint of the petitioner is that the police officials of Vadassery Police Station of Nagarcoil, came to his shop and called his son Nagarajan and when he came out of the shop some police officials from Kerala caught his son and took him to Museum Police Station, Thiruvananthapuram, in connection with a case of stolen property. According to him, on getting the information he and his family members reached Kerala and later he handed over 200 sovereigns of gold as 'thiondi' articles involved in various theft cases and he was also asked to pay more gold by the police officials of Vadassery Police Station and the Crime Branch, Nagarcoil for which he gave a complaint to the Superintendent of Police, Nagarcoil who refused to act on his complaint.

A Member of this Commission took this petition on file and asked the Chief Investigation Officer (CIO) of this Commission to enquire and file his report and the report is now filed after the Member demitted his office.

In the report it is stated that the stolen articles were recovered from the petitioner's jewellery shop by the police officials and they were recovered in connection with crime No.287/2000 and crime No.366/2000 and that there is no violation of human rights.

The above report shows that the articles were recovered in connection with the above crimes and this Commission cannot give any findings in the matter and the Court alone can decide the issue.

No further orders are required on this petition. The petition is closed.
