## ORDER

Petitioner appeared before me. The reports sent by the Managing Director, Kerala Water Authority and Secretary, Thiruvanathapuram Corporation were read over and explained to the petitioner.

It could be seen from the report of the Kerala Water Authority that the water tap near the house of the petitioner is disconnected as it was misused for washing the vehicles and the Kerala Water Authority has undertaken to restore the water tap if the Corporation give a letter for the said purpose and also to meet the expenses.

The report of the Secretary, Thiruvananthapuram Corporation shows that since the expenses for the public water tap has to be met by the Corporation and that Corporation has to pay Rs.2,628/- per tap per year the Corporation will take a decision whether a request is to be made to the Kerala Water Authority for fixing a water tap near petitioner's house after obtaining the sanction of Corporation Council.

In view of the above, I am of the view that no further order is required on this petition except to state that the Corporation will consider the request in the petition in an expeditious manner by placing it before the Corporation Council at the earliest.

With the above observation the petition is closed. Send a copy of the order to the Secretary, Corporation of Thiruvananthapuram.
