ORDER

The complaint of the petitioners is that police demolished the hut constructed by them and they were also arrested.

In the report submitted by the Superintendent of Police (Rural), Thiruvananthapuram, it is stated that the petitioners and fifteen others encroached into the disputed property violating an order passed by the Court and had put up huts. As the High Court has passed order to demolish the huts they were demolished as per the order of the Court and the petitioners were evicted. It is further stated in the report that Neyyardam Police registered crime against the petitioners and after investigation final report was filed before the Court.

In view of the above report no further orders are required as it had become subjudice and the petitioners, if they are aggrieved, have to approach only a civil

court to establish their right over the property, and the High Court, for further orders in the matter.

The petitions are accordingly closed.
