On receipt of an intimation from the Superintendent, Central Prison,

Thiruvananthapuram, regarding the death of Soman, C.No.812, S/o Velu on 7-2-

2008 at the Medical College Hospital, Thiruvananthapuram, the Superintendent

was directed to file a detailed report annexing the inquest report and the

postmortem certificate. Accordingly the Superintendent has filed the same.

On going through the inquest report I find that during the time of inquest

Sunilkumar and Anilkumar, brothers of the deceased and Rajan, son-in-law of the

deceased Soman were examined and they did not express any suspicion regarding

the death of Soman. The postmortem certificate shows that the cause of death

was on account of the occlusive vascular diseases of brain and heart (natural).

In view of the above, no further orders are required on this petition and the

petition is hence closed.
