The petitioner is the President of Sree Lakshmi Devi Temple and the petition mentions that there exists cases before the District Court, Thiruvananthapuram and the High Court of Kerala, Ernakulam, between the temple management and the respondents in respect of property dispute. The complaint of the petitioner is that on the petition filed by the respondents Fort Police registered false cases against him and others.

In the report submitted by the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Fort, it is stated that a number of cases are pending between the parties before Courts including High Court of Kerala. In the report it is further stated that on the basis

of the statement of R2 Ratnamma a crime in crime No.46/09 was registered at

Fort Police Station on 14-1-2009 and the investigation in the crime is progressing.

The report shows that the Police have registered a crime and the

investigation is pending.

In view of the report no further orders can be passed by this Commission

as per the directions contained in Supreme Court judgment in Sakri Vasu Vs. State

of U.P.& Others (AIR 2008 Supreme Court 907). The truth or otherwise of the

allegations in a crime case cannot be decided by this Commission as it is within

the exclusive jurisdiction of the Court concerned.

The petition is closed with the above observation.
