ORDER

The petitioner Lekha appeared before me and the contents of the report of the Circle Inspector of Police, Cantonment were explained to her. The petitioner gave a complaint to the Police with an allegation that her father sold the property when her husband was in Sub Jail in connection with a crime and that Police did not properly investigate. The Circle Inspector in his report stated that since the complaint of the petitioner relates to Civil dispute the Police could not proceed by registering a crime case and that she was advised to go to Civil Court. In the report it is further stated that the husband of the petitioner is involved in several cases and was also involved in a crime in which he was alleged to have set fire to a property. In view of the contents of the report no further orders are required to be passed as the matter relates to civil dispute between the petitioner and her parents. The petition is therefore closed.
