ORDER

The petitioner is present. The complaint of the petitioner is that his son

Bijukumar who went along with his friends did not return and later his dead body was

found near a bridge with his neck broken. According to him, no proper investigation is

being conducted by police.

A report was called for from the Superintendent of Police, Rural,

Thiruvananthapuram in which it is stated that a crime in crime No.484/06 was registered

u/s 174 CrPC on the basis of the statement of Binukumar, brother of the deceased.

According to the report, the body was subjected to postmortem and the death was due to

head injury as opined by the doctor. In the report it is further stated that the investigation

was entrusted to Crime Branch on 25-8-2006.

Accordingly a report was called for from the Inspector General of Police, Crime

Branch, Thiruvananthapuram and obtained. In the said report though it is stated that they

do not found any suspicion about the cause of death of Bijukumar it is not mentioned as

to the final conclusion arrived at by the investigating officer. It is also not mentioned in

the report whether the investigating officer has filed the final report before the court

either charging the accused in the crime or referring it.

In view of the above, I find it necessary to direct the Director General of Police,

Thiruvananthapuram to see that the investigation is conducted in an expeditious manner

and file the final report if it is not already over and if the investigation is already

completed and a final report was already filed before the court then the petitioner shall be

informed of the said fact by giving him the refer report so that the petitioner can work out

his remedies before the appropriate legal forum.

With the above observation the petition is closed.
