## ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that her son Richardson Gomez, who is innocent and working in a tailoring shop, was attempted to be arrested unnecessarily by the respondent and that her son escaped by running away and the respondent is obtaining bribe.

In the report submitted by the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Shangumugham, it is stated that the petitioner's son is an accused in crime Nos.371/07, 372/07, 296/08 and 297/08 of Valiyathura Police Station and after his release he created law and order problems in the area and therefore the Sub Inspector of Police, Valiyathura, directed the respondent to take action against the petitioner's son and when the respondent went to take him into custody to question him he ran away and that the petitioner's two other sons are also accused in criminal cases. According to the report, the petitioner's son was found at 10.30 p.m. on 7-3-2009 under suspicious circumstances with a weapon in his

hand and as he could not give a satisfactory explanation he was arrested, brought

to the Police Station and crime 108/09 was registered and that he was produced

before the Court and the present complaint is only on account of the cases

registered against her son.

In view of the report no further orders can be passed by this Commission

and if the petitioner has any grievance she has to seek it redressed only before a

Court as this Commission has no jurisdiction to go into the truth or otherwise of

the allegations in a crime case.

The petition is accordingly closed.
