## ORDER

The petitioner Zeenath appeared before me and she was informed the contents of the report filed by the Circle Inspector of Police, Palode. In the said report the C.I. Palode has stated that on the complaint given by the petitioner a case was registered in Crime No.4/07 by Vithura Police against the respondents and that the investigation is pending. He has also stated that since the respondents are absconding he has directed the S.I. of Police Vithura to arrest the respondents immediately and also to expedite the investigation and to file the final report before the Court. The other allegations against the Police have been denied by the Circle Inspector, Palode.

On coming to know the steps taken by the Police on the complaint given by her the petitioner stated that she will work out her remedies before the Court. She has also admitted that the respondents are absconding and hence Police could not arrest them. The petitioner further expressed her satisfaction the action taken by the local police on her petition. In view of the above report no further orders are required by this Commission. Petition is accordingly closed.
