ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that she deposited a sum of Rs.6/- lakhs on 4..8..1998 with ICICI Bank, Thiruvananthapuram Branch, and left for Malassia on 17..11..1998. According to her she returned to India in the year 2001 and came to know when she went to the Bank that huge amounts were withdrawn from the bank though she did not withdrawn any amount and hence she gave a complaint at Vanchiyoor Police Station which was registered as Crime No.104/02 u/s.406 & 407 IPC but no action is being taken against the bank officials.

In the report submitted by the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Shangumugham, it is stated that the investigation in crime No.104/02 was taken up and it is found that the following amounts were withdrawn on the following dates by the petitioner's daughter Shany and they are as follows:

1. 5..8..1998 Rs.1,50,000 – 00
2. 14..8..1998 Rs. 2,50,000 – 00

According to the report no bank officials is involved in the crime and the whereabouts of the petitioner's daughter Shany are not known and therefore a report was filed under the caption "U.N." before the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate and the petitioner has also left for Malassia in January 2009.

In view of the above report no further orders can be passed by this Commission since the court alone has jurisdiction to pass any orders in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in "Sakri Vasu vs. State of U.P. & others "AIR 2008 Supreme Court 907".

The petition is closed.
