ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that the respondents are harassing him and his parents and on 24-2-2010 the respondents damaged the boundary of his property and no action was taken by the Police.

In the report submitted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Attingal, it is stated that the petitioner and the respondents are close relatives and neighbours and that Soman Pilla constructed a fence on the boundary of the properties of the petitioner and Soman Pillai and the petitioner filed a petition before Venjaramood Police and that a spot enquiry was conducted by the Police after numbering it as No.245/Dptn/2010/VJD dated 1-3-2010. In the report it is also stated that the parties were summoned to the Police Station and were directed to redress their grievance by submitting application to the Taluk Surveyor and accordingly the petitioner filed an application before the Taluk Surveyor, Nedumangad, for

measuring his property. In the report it is further stated that on receipt of this

HRMP the parties were summoned to the Police Station and the petitioner stated

that he has filed an application before the Taluk Surveyor and hence he did not

want any further action on this HRMP and Soman Pilla has stated that he is ready

to agree to the decision of the Surveyor and he will demolish the fence if it is

found erected on the property of the petitioner..

The averments in the petition and the report show that the matter relates to

civil dispute and in view of the statement of the petitioner that he did not want

any further action on this petition since he filed an application before the Taluk

Surveyor, Nedumanagd, for the measurement of his property and in view of the

statement of Soman Pilla that he will agree with the decision of the Talyk

Surveyor after the measurement, no further orders are required on this petition.

The petition is hence closed.
