ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that a public addressing system at hospital

premises at Thalassery is causing heavy noise pollution resulting in harassment to the

residents and in spite of several complaints no action was taken.

A report was called for from the Superintendent of Police, Kannur. In the report

submitted by the Superintendent of Police it is stated that permission was granted to the

hospital as per the directions given by the Court (it is not mentioned which Court) to use

a public addressing system. It is further assured in the report that in future permission

will be granted to persons seeking to use public addressing system only after the scrutiny

of the applications from them.

The petitioner and Mr.U. Preman, Circle Inspector of Police, Thallessery,

represented by the Superintendent of Police, Kannur, are present. The complainant

reiterates his allegations. The Circle Inspector of Police produced a report which is on

the same line sent earlier and also produces the license granted to Ajayakumar, General

Convenor of the Flower Show. In the said license several conditions are mentioned and

one of the condition is that no public addressing system should be installed within 100

meters of a hospital or an educational institution. The complaint of the petitioner is that

hospital authorities conducted a flower show within the hospital premises is arranged by

Ajayakumar who is the General Convener which fact, of course, is denied by the Circle

Inspector of Police. Therefore there is a dispute as to wherer the flower show was

conducted; but that is the main issue which is the subject matter of this complaint. The

main grievance of the petitioner is that the public addressing system at the hospital is

causing noise pollution. The license granted to Ajayakumar who is the General Convener

of flower show shows that several conditions were imposed for using a public addressing

system. In the above background it is for the Police authorities to verify by giving

surprise inspections at places where public addressing systems are arranged to see that no

condition stipulated in the permission is violated.

The petitioner's complaint is that the nuisance of public addressing system at the

hospital still persist I therefore direct the Superintendent of Police, Kannur, to nominate

officers to make surprise inspections of the places where public addressing systems are

allowed to be used to verify whether the conditions stipulated in the license are strictly

complied with or not.

The petition is closed with the above directions.
