ORDER

report now received. In the report of the CIO it is stated that when he questioned the

petitioner she informed that she did not sent any complaint to this Commission and the

signature seen in the complaint is a forged one and now she is living with her husband

and two children. In her statement the petitioner, attached along with the report of the

CIO, she has mentioned the above facts.

In view of the report of the CIO and also in view of the statement of the petitioner

no further orders are required from this Commission.

The petition is, therefore, closed.
