ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that the respondent, a Principal of a Higher Secondary School, is collecting more amounts for examination fee and is quarrelling with him by calling his caste name and that he filed a complaint before the Director, Higher Secondary Education. According to him on 11..2..09 the respondent called his caste name and threatened him.

In the report submitted by the Director, Higher Secondary Education, Thiruvananthapuram, it is stated that an enquiry was conducted at Government Higher Secondary School, Nedungolam, at 11.30 a.m. on 4..6..2009 during which the petitioner, respondent, P.T.A., students and teachers were questioned and during the enquiry the allegations against the respondent were not fully proved. It is further stated that the teachers expressed good opinion about the petitioner and - 2 -

the respondent complained that the petitioner used to talk loudly at staff meetings

and not used to obey her orders.

According to the report the problems between the parties is on account of

enmity between the teachers and in any event strict instructions were given to

improve their conduct and by warning that if any such activity or activities is/are

noticed in future strict action will be initiated against the erring person/persons.

In view of the above report no further orders are required from this

Commission since the parties have been warned to enforce strict discipline and not

to give room for any complaint.

The petition is closed. .
