This is a case of custodial death. Deceased Raghavan C.No. 6246 was

a convicted prisoner under going imprisonment at Central Prison, Kannur as he

was convicted by Sessions Court (Adhoc II) Kalpetta in a SC 287/05 u/s 449,

302 and 307 of IPC for imprisonment for life

On 16.01.2010 he was having chest pain was removed to District

Hospital, Kannur when he died. I have examined post mortem certificate,

inquest report and the report of the police. Inquest was conducted by RDO,

Thalassery.

Since I have noted an observation in the colum VIII of the inquest report

a redness in both side of the chest, I have summoned the case diary and

perused in detail. It is realised that redness was caused by using the device for

taking ECG. In the post-mortem report two small abrasions were noted in the

center of chest. This was caused during resuscitation.

The doctor who conducted post-mortem opined that the prisoner died of

acute coronary insufficiency (natural death). On examining the document and

the report I am satisfied that this is case of natural death. Hence no further

enquiry is necessary.
