ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that though he obtained an injunction order from the Munsiff Court, Muvattupuzha in O.S.558/08 against the respondent preventing his entry into the petitioner's property the respondent is still entering the property and using the way. It is his further complaint that the respondent assaulted his maid servant Lakshmi Ammal and no proper action was taken by Koothattukulam Police.

In the report submitted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Muvattupuzha, it is stated that in respect of the assault on Lakshmi Ammal by the respondent crime 715/09 was registered and after completing the investigation final report was filed before the Court on 28-11-2009 and that in respect of the dispute regarding pathway the petitioner obtained an injunction order from the Court. In the report it is further stated that the parties were summoned to the

Police Station and the respondent was strictly warned not to cause any nuisance to the petitioner and also directed to obey the order of the Court.

The averments in the complaint and the report show that in respect of the pathway dispute the petitioner approached the civil court and obtained an injunction order and as regards the assault on petitioner's maid servant Police filed the final report before the Court.

In view of the above no further orders are required as the matters have become subjudiced and the petitioner has to work out his remedies before the Court concerned.

Hence the petition is closed.
