ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that her daughter-in-law Lathakumari left the petitioner's house after her husband's death with the land settled in her grandson's name along with Indira Vikas Patra for Rs,25,000/- purchased in the name of her grandson and no action was taken by police in spite of her complaint.

In the report submitted by the Commissioner of Police, Thiruvananthapuram, it is stated that the petitioner and her husband gave three cents of land and a house to her grandson and after the death of her son Lathakumari left the house and according to the report the enquiry reveals that Lathakumari left the house of the petitioner as she was not properly looked after by her husband's relatives and she is not willing to return her in-law's house as she afraid that her son may suffer. It is also reported that as the dispute between the parties is civil in nature the parties have to settle it only before the Court.

On going through the averments in the complaint and the report I am of the view that no further orders can be passed in the matter as the dispute is civil in nature between the family members.

The petition is closed.
