ORDER

The complaint of the petitioner is that crime No.93/05 registered against him by the excise officials is false.

A Member of this Commission called for a report from the Assistant Excise Commissioner, Thiruvananthapuram, and after he demitted his office the same is placed before me.

In the report submitted by the Assistant Excise Commissioner it is stated that the crime was registered against the petitioner on the ground that 300 litres of illicit liquor was seized from him on 10-3-2005 at Achavilakam Reserve Forest and that the petitioner is also manufacturing liquor and selling it.

The truth or otherwise of a crime case can be decided only by a competent criminal Court and this Commission has no jurisdiction to give such findings.

Hence the petition is closed and the petitioner is at liberty to seek his remedies before the Court.
